Mr. Balliew,

I would like to update you on the Essential Air Service (EAS) air carrier-selection case at Kirksville, and give your community the opportunity to offer its comments on the record before I submit a recommendation to the Assistant Secretary for Aviation and International Affairs. As you are aware, the Department issued Order 2020-1-10 on January 28, 2020, requesting proposals from airlines interested in providing EAS at Kirksville for a new contract term. In response to that Order, three airlines submitted proposals to serve Kirksville:

- Air Choice One
- Boutique Air
- Cape Air

In a previous e-mail to you, I attached each airline's proposal for your community's review. Those proposals have been uploaded to [www.regulations.gov](http://www.regulations.gov) under docket number DOT-OST-1997-2515. It is important that your community review each proposal carefully.
