I would like to update you on the Essential Air Service (EAS) situation at Karluk as well as give you an opportunity to offer any comments for the formal record before we submit a recommendation to the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Aviation and International Affairs. As you may know, the Department issued Order 2020-6-19 on June 29, 2020, soliciting proposals from air carriers interested in providing EAS Karluk new term.
