Statement of Reciprocity

This statement is to guarantee that the undersigned the President of the Civil Aviation Authority will positively consider applications submitted by the U.S.-registered air carriers for permissions to perform single non-scheduled commercial flights on the basis of 5th/7th aviation freedom rights, to/from the territory of the Republic of Poland to/from the territory of any country on condition that all our applicable national regulations and provisions of the binding international agreements are satisfied by such air carriers.

The Statement of Reciprocity shall remain in force for an unlimited period of time and as long as equivalent applications of air carriers holding the operating license issued by the President of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Republic of Poland continue to be positively considered by the Civil Aviation Authority of the United States of America on the basis of reciprocity.
