Change of Service Pattern for SkyWest Airlines' Essential Air Service in Meridian and Laurel/Hattiesburg

Effective July 1st, 2020 SkyWest Airlines is requesting a change in service pattern at Meridian and Laurel/Hattiesburg from Dallas/Fort Worth and Chicago O'Hare service on an American Airlines codeshare to George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) on a United Airlines codeshare. There is no requested change in subsidy.

This change will facilitate continued reliable air service to both communities and does not represent a change in the operating carrier. All flights will be marketed under the United Airlines brand, which will continue to provide seamless connections to the world.
