## APPLICATION OF POLAR AIR CARGO WORLDWIDE, INC. FOR RENEWAL OF EXEMPTION AUTHORITY

Pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §40109 and Subpart C of the Department's Rules of Practice, Polar Air Cargo Worldwide, Inc. ("Polar") respectfully requests renewal of its exemption authority granted by Notice of Action Taken, issued August 12, 2016, in the above-referenced Docket. The exemption authority enables Polar to engage in scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail from points in the U.S., via intermediate points, to points in Mexico, and beyond.

In support of this request, Polar respectfully states as follows:

- 1. Polar is a Delaware corporation having its principal place of business at 2000 Westchester Avenue, Purchase, NY 10577 and a citizen of the United States within the meaning of 49 U.S.C. §40102(1)(15)(C). It holds various certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide domestic and foreign air transport.
  - 3. This application is consistent with the new U.S.-Mexico air transport agreement.

Grant of this application is in the public interest because it increases the chances that valuable bilateral rights can and will be put use in the interest of the shipping public.

4. The continuation of these services will not cause a near-term net annual change in aircraft fuel consumption of ten million gallons or more. Grant of this application does not qualify as a major regulatory action under Part 313 of the Department's rules.

WHEREFORE, Polar requests the renewal if its exemption authority authorizing it to engage in scheduled foreign air transportation of property and mail to/from Mexico to the fullest extent available under the U.S.-Mexico air transport agreement, and such other and further relief as the Department determines to be consistent with this application and the public interest.
