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Pursuant to Order 2020-1-16 (the “Show Cause Order”) and Order 2020-5-7 (the “Final Order”)¹ of the Department of Transportation (“DOT” or the “Department”), iAero respectfully submits this notice of cancellation of charter flights allocated in this docket.

The cancelled flights were scheduled to occur between August 1 and August 14, 2020 on behalf of the following charter operator customers:

It is iAero's understanding that the Government of Cuba is considering issuing another Notice to Airmen ("NOTAM") that would have the effect of prohibiting these flights due to concerns about the COVID-19 pandemic. While the NOTAM has not to iAero's knowledge been issued, iAero and its customers are taking the proactive measure of cancelling the flights due to the COVID-19 concerns. As a result, 102 flights will be returned to the charter pool for reallocation.
