Pursuant to Order 2020-5-7, ordering paragraph 9, Caribbean Sun Airlines, Inc. d/b/a World Atlantic Airlines ("WAA") respectfully requests that the Department distribute up to 102¹ charters to WAA from the U.S.-Havana 2020-2021 charter pool for additional operations with MD-83 aircraft on behalf of Havana Air. A schedule of these 102 proposed, additional flights is attached.

WAA has firm plans to use the requested distribution. It is submitting a copy of the charter addendum under seal with a request for confidential treatment.

1 On July 22, 2020 Swift Air d/b/a iAero returned 102 charters to the pool, and WAA notified the Department that it was cancelling 12 flights; WAA further explained that it appeared those charter allocations could be used to operate other Havana Air flights. iAero opposed WAA's notification, citing informal Department guidance of which WAA was unaware.

WAA would of course appreciate the Department's public clarification as to how carriers should address cancellations which the affected charter operator could "pick up" later in the charter year. In acting on this request, WAA would also appreciate a determination as to whether the 12 charters at issue were returned to the pool (and therefore subject to this request) or had already remained available to WAA/Havana Air.
