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Pursuant to Order 2020-1-16 (the “Show Cause Order”) and Order 2020-5-7 (the “Final Order”)¹ of the Department of Transportation (“DOT” or the “Department”), iAero respectfully submits this notice of cancellation of charter flights allocated in this docket.

The cancelled flights were scheduled to occur during August 16-31, 2020 on behalf of the following charter operator customers:

It is iAero's understanding that the Government of Cuba will issue a Notice to Airmen ("NOTAM") announcing that flights will not resume until at least September 1, 2020. Having previously cancelled flights between August 1 – 14, and then for August 15, Swift now cancels them for August 16-31. As a result, 117 flights will be returned to the charter pool for reallocation.
