MONTHLY SERVICE OBLIGATION REPORT OF UNITED AIRLINES, INC.

As required by the Service Obligation Order (“Order”)¹ issued by the Department of Transportation (“Department”), United Airlines, Inc. (“United”), by and through its authorized representative, certifies that, except as noted below, it has operated service during June of 2020 in accordance with its obligations established by the Order, as modified by exemptions granted by the Department pursuant to its Notices of Action Taken and Final Order on Adjustments to Service Obligations.² The following points did not receive service to the minimum service levels established by the Order, for the reasons noted:

- Gunnison, Colorado (GUC) – Due to a schedule change that was implemented on June 4th, United altered the days of the week that it operated a flight to GUC from Thursday, Friday, and Monday in May to Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday in June. As a result of the timing of the cut over to this schedule, United operated two instead of three flights to GUC during the first week of June.
