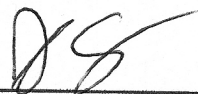

FRONTIER AIRLINES' MONTHLY AIR SERVICE CERTIFICATION

I, Daniel Shurz, Senior Vice President, Commercial hereby certify that:

1. With the exceptions noted below, Frontier Airlines, Inc. ("Frontier") has operated service in accordance with its Service Obligation in DOT Order 2020-4-2, as modified by DOT Notice of Action Taken, dated April 25, 2020, and DOT Order 2020-6-2, for the month of July 2020.
2. Frontier did not operate one of its flights during the week of June 29 – July 5 for each of the following points: Albuquerque (ABQ), Spokane (GEG), Reno (RNO), and Louisville (SDF). Frontier did not operate one of its flights during the week of July 20 – July 26 to Harlingen (HRL), and during the week of July 27 – August 2 to Palm Beach (PBI).
3. Frontier originally scheduled these flights to each of these destinations. However, for operational reasons, Frontier was unable to operate one of the flights to each of the destinations as described above. Specifically, the ABQ, GEG, RNO, and SDF flights could not be operated because of flight crew availability. The HRL and PBI flights could not be operated because of weather.
4. Pursuant to Title 18 United States Code Section 1001, I, Daniel Shurz, in my individual capacity and as the authorized representative of Frontier Airlines, have not in any manner knowingly and willfully falsified, concealed or failed to disclose any material fact or made any false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or knowingly used any documents which contain such statements in connection with the preparation, filing or prosecution of this Monthly Air Service Certification. I understand that an individual who is found to have violated the provisions of 18 U.S.C. Section 1001 shall be fined or imprisoned not more than five years, or both.
