The EPA and the Environmental Health and Safety Committee of the PSTC met (via phone) to discuss the completion of the POWC RTR. The EPA provided an overview of the path forward for completing the RTR by the March 13, 2020 court-ordered deadline. The PSTC representatives provided a review of the comments they submitted to the docket in response to the proposal published in the Federal Register on September 19, 2019. No new information was discussed.
