Dear Mr. Carty,

On May 23, 2015, Florida Air Transport (FAT) petitioned for exemption from 14 CFR Part 125.265 (a)(b) and 14 CFR Part 91.529 (a)(b), "Flight Engineer requirements of 50 hours flight time within 6 months on type airplane". In our petition, we requested that our Flight Engineers be approved to maintain currency by using as Event Based Currency (EBC) program rather than logging 50 hours of flight time or completing a competency check every 6 months.

On February 21, 2020, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), through your office, reissued Exemption No. 17116 granting our request as well as approving Revision #1 to the EBC Event Requirements.

This exemption stated a termination date of February 28, 2022. We are requesting that this exemption either have a continuance or a new exemption issued based on the same arguments stated in our original May 23, 2015 petition.
