Due to the effects of Covid-19 and travel restrictions in place in the State of Hawaii, I am unable to have my FAA Far Part 135 Proficiency Check administered to me. This serves as my letter of intent to exercise Exemption No. 18510B and I affirm it is my intention to act consistently with the conditions and limitations of Exemption 18510B. I understand that this exemption is only for Jason Darr will expire on 11/31/2020 and I will not conduct any 135 operations after that date unless a 135.293 check ride has been successfully completed as conducted by an FAA inspector. In order to mitigate any risk, I will only conduct the types of operations that I have experience in during my previous 15 years of employment at Jack Harter Helicopters.

I request that a copy of this Exemption 18510B be added to DCGA Operations Specifications A005 for issuance.
