Dear Petitioner:

This is in response to your February 3, 2022 letter sent to the public docket (Docket No. FAA-2022-0214) petitioning the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) on behalf of RonLyn LLS (RonLyn) for an exemption from various regulations codified in Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR). Your petition indicates that you believe an exemption is necessary to permit you to operate small unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) to conduct roof treatment aircraft operations.

An exemption from the regulations from which you seek relief is not necessary because existing FAA regulations permit your operation. On June 28, 2016, the first operational rules for routine commercial use of small UAS were codified at 14 CFR part 107. Part 107 applies to operations of small unmanned aircraft weighing less than 55 pounds. See 14 CFR § 107.1 for a detailed description of the applicability of part 107.

Because the rules of 14 CFR part 107 apply to your proposed operations, relief from the regulations you cited in your petition is not necessary. As a result, the FAA will take no further action on your petition.
