To Whom It May Concern:

Executive Jet Management, Inc. (EJM) intends to exercise relief granted in exemption 19176 and affirms our intention to comply with all conditions and limitations listed in this exemption. This letter of intent filed to the Federal eRulemaking Portal, under Docket No. FAA-2022-0795, complies with the requirement of this exemption.

Exemption 19176 delays the June 10, 2022 milestone of the Pilot Records Database (PRD) reporting requirement until the FAA implements electronic data transfer of pilot records to the PRD. Records created June 10, 2022 through January 10, 2023 will be reported to the Pilot Records Database by June 12, 2023.

EJM is a member of the NBAA, is a Part 119 certificate holder conducting operations under Part 135, and currently holds Operations Specification A025 for electronic training records.

This exemption expires on January 10, 2023. Please inform me if you require any additional information with this letter of intent.
