This letter is in response to your January 24, 2023 letter sent to the federal docket, Docket No. FAA-2023-0256. In your letter you petitioned the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) on behalf of Colsa Corporation (Colsa) for an exemption from § 89.105 of Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR). If granted, the exemption would allow Colsa to operate its small unmanned aircraft system without remote broadcast modules.

The relief you requested is covered by 14 CFR § 89.105, which contains deviation authority. You can submit an application for authorization using form 7711-2, available online in an electronic form, and submit to ridauthorizations@faa.gov.
