#### STANDARD CONDITIONS

- 1. A personal effects permit must specify that the permit holder must apply for a possession permit. The personal effects permit must reflect, in addition to any other information stipulated, the REGISTRATION NUMBER or STANDING PERMIT number of the registered
- 2. Consideration of future applications will be based on, among other things, whether any permit issued to the landowner of the registered game farm / wildlife trader has been cancelled in terms of section 93 of the Biodiversity Act.

  3. No listed species may be transported without the necessary permits in terms of the Threatened or Rotected Species Regulations.
- Provide information, relating to security measures to prevent theft, with each renewal.
- 5. The game farm/s must be fenced in accordance with the specifications provided for in provincial legislation and the Certificate of Adequate Enclosure must be renewed at least 3 months prior to the expiry thereof.
- 6. The landowner of the registered game farm must RETURN ALL THE COPIES of the Game Farm Munting permits USED DURING A 12-MONTH PERIOD to the issuing authority; and must submit a list of any unused permit numbers to theissuing authority.
- 7. The permit holder may apply for game farm hunting permits, authorising a person to buy and huntalisted threatened or protected species, on the registered game farm and for the subsequent transport and possession of the dead specimen/s that was hunted.
- 8. The permit holder must give regard to any other applicable legislation and/or protocols.
- 9. The permit holder must keep a register of past, current and anticipated turnover of stock on an annul basis.
- 10. The permit holder must keep evidence of legal acquisition of the listed species in his possession.
- 11. The permit holder must take reasonable measures to ensure that captured animals do not injure each other and are transported under hygienic conditions.
- 12. This permit or a certified copy thereof must always be kept at the facility or in the vehicle used forthe transportation of animals.
- 13. This permit or a certified copy thereof must be shown to any authorized official upon request.
- 14. Where applicable the permit holder must microchip the listed species or ensure that animal/s he like receives are microchipped.
- 15. The permit holder may apply for a personal effects permit for dead, processed specimen/s or definitives.
- 16. The permit holder must adhere to applicable National Norms and Standards and is bound by thos Norms and Standards and must act in accordance with those Norms and Standards when carrying out the restricted activity.
- 17. The owner must take reasonable measures in ensuring that the fence is in a good state of repair which includes but not limited to the following:

Regular fence patrols,

Fence repairs and maintenance must be according to the Departmental Fencing Specifications Policytocument, applicable at the time of such repairs

#### SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Any supplement to the stock of black wildebeest/bontebok on the property from an external sourcemust be sourced from a property where a registered/permitted herd of black wildebeest/bontebok already occur
- 2. Any transport of ToPS species off the property requires an application for an ordinary permit in terms of NEMBA Act 10 of 2004. In addition to this, any transport of bontebok off the property is to be accompanied by DNA tet results.
- 3. This permit is subject to a valid CAE in terms of the Nature and Environmental Conservation Ordinace 19 of 1974;
- 4. The species listed in this standing permit in terms of NEMBA: Threatened and/or Species Regulations are adequately enclosed. The ownership of the species listed is therefore maintained in terms of the Game Theft Act \$5 of 1991
- 5. Restricted activities on this permit include possession in an extensive wildlife system, hunting and epture. They do not include transport off the property where a separate permit is to be applied for.
- This permit or a certified copy thereof must always be kept at the facility or vehicle used what the restricted 6.

# Customs Rules on Discharge of Importers Liability for Duties

The U.S. Customs Service has issued a final amendment of the regulations to provide an alternative procedure tran Importer record to pay duties on imported merchandise through a licensed customhouse broker. Present rules provide for the payment of duties to Customs by a broker on behalf of the importer. Under the alternative procedure, the importer may elect to submit to the broker a separate check or bank draft for the dules payable to the "U.S. Customs Service". The broker would then deliver the Importer's check or bank draft to Customs. The new rule also requires brokers to provide written notification to their clients, advising that if I the client is an Importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve the client of liability for Customs charge in the event that the charges are not paid by the broker. Brokers will be required to provide this notification to all active clients annually during the month of Felmary. Additionally, brokers will be required to provide such information on a power of attorney executed on or after the effective date of the new rule. These amendments are effective as of September 27, 1982
